First Quarter 2015 Distributions

With the authorization of its board of directors, HMS Income Fund recently declared distributions for the months of January - March 2015 with respect to shares of its common stock, par value \$0.001 per share (the "Common Stock"). These distributions will be calculated based on stockholders of record each day from January 1, 2015 through March 31, 2015 in an amount equal to \$0.00191781 per share of Common Stock, per day (which represents an annualized distribution yield of 7% based on HMS Income Fund's current public offering price of \$10.00 per share of Common Stock, if it were maintained everyday for a twelve-month period). Distributions will be paid on the first business day following the completion of each month to which they relate. All distributions will be paid in cash or reinvested in Common Stock for those participating in HMS Income Fund's distribution reinvestment plan.
